### "Rotating Shelter Here In July"

Our parish will host the Faith in Action Rotating Shelter for Homeless Men during the month of July. This is the 17th year that our parish will be participating in this program. A number of local churches, synagogues, and community groups work with West Valley Community Services to provide food, shelter, support, case management, referral services, and transitional housing for homeless men who are willing and able to find gainful employment and a place to live. The shelter rotates to a different church/congregation each month.

**We need your help to provide meals, or act as shoppers or greeters.** We will need **dinner**s for 16 men delivered warm and ready to eat each evening at 8:00 p.m. to our AV room (at the end of the school building). Also, we would like to provide light **breakfasts** on weekends (bread/rolls and fruit). **Shoppers** will be needed to stop in at 8:00 p.m. to check on breakfast and lunch materials and to buy what is needed. Shoppers may donate their purchases or be reimbursed from our Outreach fund. **Greeters**, acting as our friendly parish representatives, are needed to we come to the shelter at 7:45 p.m. and stay for about an hour to welcome and socialize with the guests as they return from work or job-hunting. 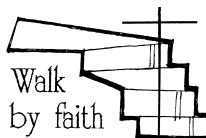
**Stewardship at St. Joseph of Cupertino**

**Matthew 19:14** *Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."*

The sound of a baby’s cry is the sound of the Church growing. We gather as family to celebrate the Eucharist. If someone in our family needs help with a young one, perhaps you can help. You would be surprised how good it would make you feel to help a parent in need, and how well they will remember the kindness you show. We do have a cry room, and like the rest of the building, it dates back to the 1950s. It seats about 12 people, and is useful for those times when an infant is crying a lot, or for very active toddlers.

We must remember that these young children are the Church of the future and do all we can to bring them to Jesus Christ, as he said.
