Farewell, Fr. Vincent

Bishop McGrath has appointed Fr. Vincent Pineda parochial vicar of St. Mary Parish in Gilroy, effective July 1, 2012. Our parish community will bid farewell to Fr. Vincent at receptions following each mass on the weekend of June 23-24. Among the ministries in which he has been involved here are the infant baptism preparation, altar server, young adult, and social justice ministries.

Our new parochial vicar will be Fr. Athanasius Kikoba, currently in residence at St. Athanasius Parish in Mountain View. Fr. Athanasius will not be with us until the middle of July, when he will return to our diocese from a visit to his native country of Uganda in East Africa

Rotating Shelter News

This is the 20th year that St. Joseph of Cupertino has participated in the Faith in Action Silicon Valley Rotating Shelter program for homeless men in our area. We will be hosting the shelter once again for the month of July in our parish, providing shelter, food, and assistance to 15 men who are willing and able to work and to regain their independence.

Faith in Action provides professional case management, overnight supervisors, and other supportive services for our clients. The applicants are carefully screened, are drug and alcohol free, and are allowed to stay for a period of up to 90 days, as long as they are in compliance with program requirements and are making progress towards the goal of self-sufficiency and permanent housing.

From June 29 till July 28, the shelter will be located in our parish hall/school, and we will be asking for your assistance to provide dinners, do shopping for breakfast and lunch materials, and to act as greeter/host. During the month of June, you will see parish volunteers sitting at sign-up tables outside all Masses, and we hope you will consider helping the shelter program in some capacity.

Note: Please don't forget that St. Joseph's provides dinner for the shelter once a month, on the third Saturday. Our next date is June 16th. In June, the shelter is located at another area church, and the food will need to be delivered there warm and ready to serve at 8:00 p.m. If you'd like to help, or for more information, please call Mary Ellen Hennig (408) 255-6382. The Young Adults Group normally meets every Saturday at 7 pm in the SJC youth/young adults ministry room, across from the baseball field.


