

## Rotating Shelter News

The shelter has been housed here at St. Joseph's since June 29, and things are going great! A BIG THANK YOU to the many (almost 100!) parish volunteers who have been meal providers, grocery and supplies shoppers, or greeters. Also, many thanks to those who have donated goods or contributed monetarily to the shelter program.

Our parish is committed to this endeavor, and has been most generous in setting aside parish rooms and facilities for the shelter during this month. The in-kind donated services, including the designated space and utilities and donations of food and supplies comprise about half of the shelter budget each month, and we could not operate without such generous participation.

If you wish to help with a monetary gift, it would be most gratefully accepted, to help cover operating costs, such as the salaries of the professional case manager and overnight supervisors, insurance, etc. Faith in Action Silicon Valley Rotating Shelter is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization in its own right, and all gifts are tax deductible. A little more information: this is the 20<sup>th</sup> year that St. Joseph of Cupertino parish has participated as a hosting site for the shelter. Each month, the shelter "rotates" to a different church, and July has traditionally been our month. Faith in Action serves 15 guests at a time, and provides professional case management, overnight supervisors, and other supportive services for our clients. The applicants are carefully screened, are drug and alcohol free, and are allowed to stay for a period of up to 90 days, as long as they are in compliance with program requirements and are making progress towards the goal of self-sufficiency and permanent housing.


